II. Purpose of Addendum

On June 2, 2011, a modification request was received from Rainbow Child Development Center. They are requesting to add the basement as child use space for children 3 years to 12 years of age and increase their capacity from 83 children to 108.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Rainbow Child Development Center –Okemos has been operating with a total capacity of 83 children, ages birth through 12 years of age in the following rooms:

- Infant room 1 measures a total of 400 square feet. This allows for a total room capacity of 8 children ages birth to 2 ½ years.
- Infant room 2 measures a total of 400 square feet. This allows for a total room capacity of 8 children ages birth to 2 ½ years.
- Toddler room measures 588 square feet. This allows for a total room capacity of 12 children ages of 2 ½ to 3 years.
- Preschool room measures 630 square feet. This allows for a total room capacity of 18 children ages 3 years to 12 years.
- Pre-Kindergarten room measures 577 square feet. This allows for a total room capacity of 16 children ages 3 years to 12 years.
- School Age room measures a total of 722 square feet. This allows for a total room capacity of 21 children ages 3 years to 12 years.

The program is now approved to use the basement of the building for children ages 3 years to 12 years. The following rooms in the basement are approved for use:

- Varsity Club room measures 40 x 27, plus 15 x 17, providing a total of 1335 square feet. This allows for a total room capacity of 37 children, ages 3 years to 12 years.
- Gymnasium measures 42 x 21 for a total of 882 square feet. This allows for a total room capacity of 25 children, ages 3 years to 12 years. The capacity of

this room was not used to determine the overall capacity of the center.

The Varsity Club room has enough space for an additional 37 children. This is more than enough space to accommodate the request to increase the total center capacity from 83 to 108 children, age birth to 12 years.

The main floor of the center has 9 toilets and 8 sinks, and the basement has 3 toilets and 3 sinks. This is a total of 12 toilets and 11 sinks throughout the center, which supports the capacity of 108 children.

The additional rooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. There is an adequate amount of equipment to support the center's capacity.

An environmental health inspection was completed on November 21, 2011. A fire safety inspection was completed on May 25, 2012. A lead risk assessment is not required because the building was built in 1997.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of the Varsity Club room and the gym located in the basement of the building as approved child use space for children ages 3 years to 12 years. I further recommend a capacity increase from 83 to 108 children, birth through 12 years of age.
