II. Purpose of Addendum

On October 29, 2014 program director Crystal Jeon-Lapree requested approval for new use space and an increase in capacity from 50 to 71 children from birth through 10 years of age.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on January 21, 2015.

The previously approved child use space continues to be used. The measurements are as follows:

- Room 102 Infant/toddler classroom measures 22 ft. x 32 ft. for a total of 704 square feet. This is sufficient space for 14 children ages 6 weeks to 2.5 years. **The maximum group size for infants and young toddlers is 12.** If the room is divided to accommodate 14 children then each group of children would need a lead caregiver.
- Room 107 Older toddler/preschool classroom measures 23 ft. x 32 ft. for a total of 736 square feet. This is sufficient space for 21 children ages 30 months to 10 years. **The maximum group size for older toddlers is 16.** If the room is divided to accommodate 16 older toddlers then each group of children would need a lead caregiver.

On January 14, 2015 I inspected and measured the space requested for additional use space. The measurements are as follows:

- Room 108 Pre-K room measures 23 ft. x 32 ft. for a total of 736 square feet. This is sufficient space for 21 children ages 4 to 5 years of age.

The total space is sufficient for a total center capacity of 71 children, birth through age 10.

There are a total of 5 toilets, 2 urinals and 5 sinks to be used by children in care which is more than is required for use by 71 children.

The classroom is furnished with a variety of developmentally age appropriate equipment. The inventory list reflects sufficient equipment to support the increase in capacity from 50 to 71.

Environmental health and fire safety inspections of all areas were completed at the time of original issuance; new inspections are not required. A lead risk assessment was completed on January 6, 2012. The center passed with lead levels below the EPA/HUD regulatory limit.

The center is approved for a total capacity of 71 children ages birth through 10 years old.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval for the use of room 108 as new use space and an increase in capacity from 50 to 71.
