## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

### A. Description of Facility

#### **Rooms and levels approved for child care use:**

Ms. Hunter resides in a two story home with a basement. On the main level, the playroom on the north side of the home and living room on the west side of the home are approved for child care use and exceed the 35 sq. ft. requirement for each child.

#### **Areas not approved:**

The basement and upper levels are not approved as child use space.

#### **Ages of children served:**

The group home will serve children 12 months to 12 years.

#### **Equipment:**

Ms. Hunter has a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate indoor and outdoor equipment.

#### **Proposed days and hours of operation:**

The group home will operate from 6:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday.

**Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care:**

Ms. Hunter was previously registered as a family home, DF230315024, which is currently closed. She was not previously nor is she currently licensed to provide children's foster care.

**Exiting information (including second floor and basement):**

The remote exits on the main level include the door off the play room leading to the north side of the home and the front door off the living room leading to the west side of the home.

**Outdoor play area description:**

The outdoor play area is not fenced and located on the north side of the home.


