

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8340 Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.

(2) Breast milk, formula, milk, or other beverages provided in a same-day supply must be furnished daily in either of the following:

(b) A clean, sanitary, beverage container. The beverage must be poured into a clean, sanitary bottle or beverage container before each feeding.

A child's bottle from home was being re filled with milk throughout the day. The bottle was not washed rinsed and sanitized before uses and each feeding.

R 400.8340 Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.

(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.

One bottle in the toddler room was uncovered and two children's bottles in the infant room were uncovered. Two children's bottles only had their last initial, these must be first and last name.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 02/10/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license.
