## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

### **R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.**

(6) All child care staff members who work directly with children shall complete 16 clock hours of professional development

annually on topics relevant to job responsibilities that include, but are not limited to, any of the following subjects:

- (a) Child development and learning.
- (b) Health, safety, and nutrition.
- (c) Family and community collaboration.
- (d) Program management.
- (e) Teaching and learning.
- (f) Observation, documentation, and assessment.
- (g) Interactions and guidance.
- (h) Child care center administrative rules.

The following caregivers did not have documentation of the required 16 clock hours of training for 2021.

Ms. Godsey completed 7 clock hours in 2021.

Ms. Anthony completed 7 clock hours in 2021.

Ms. S. Pierik completed 5 clock hours in 2021.

Ms. Newhard completed 7 clock hours in 2021.

Ms. Ozechowski completed 5 clock hours in 2021.

Ms. Permaloff completed 5 clock hours in 2021.

(2) Child information cards must be reviewed and updated by parents at least annually and when the center becomes aware of changes.

Two child information cards were not updated annually.

**R 400.8143 Children's records.**

(6) Within 30 days of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain, keep on file, and make accessible in the center a record of a physical evaluation of the child that notes any restrictions and is signed by a physician or the physician's designee. An electronic record from a physician's office will be accepted. The physical evaluation must be performed within 1 of the following time limits:

(a) For an infant, within the preceding 3 months.

One physical did not have an examination date and one physical did not list restrictions.

**R 400.8143 Children's records.**

- (7) Physical evaluations must be updated as follows:
  - (a) Yearly for infants and toddlers.

Two toddlers physicals were not updated yearly.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 02/10/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
