## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

### A. Description of Facility

Nanny's Nursery Infant and Toddler Center is located in the City of Taylor near the Intersection of Telegraph and Goddard.

#### **Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):**

The full building is approved for child care. It will service infants through older toddlers. A capacity of 32 has been granted with the following breakdown for use space:

- The infant room is separated by a door and measures 411 square feet. It's approved for 8 infants based on 50 sq ft per child.

The remaining space is a large open room. It's divided by shelving units for the young and older toddlers.

- The blue side is for younger toddlers and measures 607 square feet. It will accommodate 12 children, between 12 to 29 months of age, based on 50 sq ft. per child.
- The yellow side is for older toddlers and measures 609 square feet. It will accommodate 12 children 30 to 35 months of age based on 35 sq ft per child.

**Equipment:**

Nanny's Nursery Infant and Toddler Center has varied and sufficient equipment. A detailed equipment list is on file.

**Number of sinks and toilets:**

The facility has two toilets and one hand washing sink.

**Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards:**

The fenced outdoor play area is across the parking lot. The square footage exceeds 1200 square feet.

**Documentation if a lead assessment was required and the results:**

A lead inspection is not required for this new building.

**Documentation of playground safety:**

A playground inspection is not required. There is no in-ground equipment.

**B. Program Description**

**Ages of children served:**

Nanny's Nursery Infant and Toddler Center will service children six months through 35 months of age.

**Proposed days and hours of operation:**

The facility will operate Monday through Friday from 06:00 am to 06:00 p.m.

**Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both):**

This is a full day program.

**Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service:**

The facility is not offering food service or transportation. The licensee is aware that **prior** approval from the department and environmental health is required for any change in nutritional services.

**Name of program director and under what rule the program director is qualified. Document how the center meets the administrative requirement if a variance was granted.**

The approved program director is Christina Baksa. Ms. Baksa has a CDA and 24 semester hours in Child Development. Her CPR and First Aid is current and on file with the department.
