IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The licensee requested to have room 129 approved as child use space. Room 129 has 770 square feet of useable space which will accommodate the licensed capacity of 20. Room 129 will be used as additional space for the school age- after school and preschool programs.

Currently the school-age after school program utilizes the school’s gymnasium and room 127. The preschool program currently utilizes room 110 and the school’s gymnasium.

An environmental health inspection was completed on 03/25/09 which included this room therefore a new inspection was not required. The school provided the “Documentation of School Building Compliance with Fire Safety” form on 03/16/11; a fire inspection is not required.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the approval of room 129 as child use space.
