## **II. Purpose of Addendum**

The licensee designee, Sivakami Rajendran, is requesting an increase in the licensed capacity from 20 to 45 children. She is also requesting an increase in the age range of the license from 2.6 years – 6 years to 2.6 years - 12 years.

## **III. Methodology**

## **IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions**

The center was previously approved to use the same two classrooms but based on the request of the licensee designee, the capacity was limited to 20 children at any one time. At the time of initial licensure, the requested capacity of 20 children age 2-1/2 to 6 years was based on center enrollment. Interest in the center has increased and the licensee is anticipating a larger enrollment over the summer and in the fall.

The licensee will continue to use these same two rooms and understands that the center cannot accommodate more than the newly requested capacity of 45 children, age 2-1/2 to 12 years at any one time.

- Room 1, approximately 1,090 square feet, can accommodate up to 31 children at 35 square feet per child between the age of 2 years 6 months and 12 years.
- Room 2, approximately 1,050 square feet, can accommodate up to 30 children at 35 square feet per child between the age of 2 years 6 months and 12 years.

There are 4 toilets and 3 hand-washing sinks available for the children's use. This limits the capacity of this full-time program to 45 children at any one time.

The total space, including restrooms, equals a total capacity of 45 children, age 2-1/2 to 12 years. The licensee designee understands that caregiver to child ratio is determined by the age of the youngest child in the group.

Ms Rajendram has enough equipment to accommodate the increase in capacity and age range.

The fire and health inspections are less than a year old and are not needed for this modification. The building was constructed after 1978, therefore a lead inspection was not required. There is no playground equipment

There is no change in hours.

Ms Rajendram provided a written program plan and equipment list for the additional children ages 6 years to 12 years of age.

Additional staff will be hired as the enrollment increases.

**V. Recommendation**

I recommend the center's capacity be increased from 20 to 45 children and that the age range be changed to accommodate children age 2-1/2 to 12 years.
