On February 12, 2013, the registrant requested we add an additional bedroom to her approved child use space.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The family child care home is located in the village of Climax. The home is a single story structure with a basement. The main floor living room, entry/dining room, kitchen, one bedroom, and bathroom on the west side of the home are all approved for child care use. The registrant would like to add a second bedroom (playroom) to her approved space. The master bedroom, master bathroom, and laundry room on the main level of the home are not approved for care. The basement level of the home is not approved except in severe weather emergencies.

The outdoor play area is located behind the house and is fully fenced. The registrant does not have any hot tubs, swimming pools, fireplaces, wood burning stoves, or water hazards on the premises. The family has two small dogs that are kept in a private part of the home during child care hours.

The registrant has a sufficient supply of developmentally appropriate and varied equipment to accommodate the requested capacity of six children. The registrant will accept children birth through age seventeen. The family child care home is open from Monday through Friday from 5:00 AM to 5:30 PM. Ms. Gross has not been previously registered/licensed as a child care provider and is not licensed for child foster care. No variances have been requested or granted.

A radon test was completed on the basement level of the home on 10/10/2008, and the results measured at 1.0 pCi/L. Ms. Gross has current certification in CPR, first aid, and has completed blood-borne pathogen training.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the modification to include the additional bedroom (playroom) on the main level of the home as approved child-use space.
