II. Purpose of Addendum

On August 7, 2014 the licensee designee requested that classroom 2 be approved for GSRP, ages 2.5 to 5 years of age.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on September 6, 2012, December 12, 2013, April 21, 2014 and August 20, 2014.

Pumpkin Patch is located in the Kearsley School District in the former Buffy Elementary. The building is no longer considered a school building because the building only operates as an early childhood building.

Ms. Akers has requested to change the GSRP classroom from Room 11 to Room 2. Room 2 is 27 ft. x 28 ft. providing a total of 756 square feet. This is sufficient space for 22 children aged 2.5 to 5 years in the classroom. There is one sink in the room.

The following areas were previously inspected and approved:

- The GSRP classroom 1 is 36 ft. x 28 ft., providing a total of 1,008 square feet. This allows for a total capacity of 24 children aged 2.5 to 5 years. There is one sink in the room.
- The Child Development classrooms 5 and 6 (combined) are 27 ft. x 28 ft. plus 27 ft. x 28 ft. providing a total of 1,512 square feet. This allows for a total capacity of 43 children aged 2.5 to 5 years. There are two sinks in the room.
- The Infant-Toddler classroom 7 is 28 ft. x 28 ft. providing a total of 758 square feet. This allows for a total capacity of 12 children aged birth to 3 years. There is one sink in the room.
- The Montessori classroom 8 is 28 ft. x 28 ft. providing a total of 758 square feet. This allows for a total capacity of 22 children aged 2.5 to 5 years. There is one sink in the room.
- The Extended Care classroom 13 is 27.5 ft. x 28 ft. providing a total of 770

square feet. This allows for a capacity of 22 children aged 2.5 to 12 years. There is one sink in the room.

- The Latchkey classroom 14 is 28 ft. x 28 ft. providing a total of 784 square feet. This allows for a capacity of 22 children aged 2.5 to 12 years. There is one sink in the room.

The following room is approved as additional child use space and is not used to determine the center's total capacity:

- Gymnasium is 46 ft. x 56 ft. providing a total of 2,576 square feet. This allows for a capacity of 73 children ages 2.5 - 5 years. The gymnasium will not be counted in the center's capacity.

The total space is sufficient for a total center capacity of 167 children, birth through 12 years of age.

There are a total of 20 hand washing sinks, 16 toilets, and 3 urinals located throughout the center. This supports the center's capacity.

The classrooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. There is an adequate amount of equipment to support the capacity of the facility.

The facility received an "A" rated Fire Safety Inspection on June 19, 2012. An "A" rated Environmental Health Inspection was completed on March 26, 2014. A Lead Risk assessment was completed on June 28, 2011. No lead-based hazards were identified. A playground inspection was completed on March 23, 2012.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of room 2 for GSRP, ages 2.5 to 5 years.
