II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee, Christina Morales, requested to add an infant/toddler component to the current license of Eternal Rock.

III. Methodology

07/14/2014 – Contact – document received request for modification

10/21/2014 – Inspection completed – Environmental health A rating

10/24/2014 - Inspection completed – Onsite.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of this child care license were modified on 10/27/2014.

Room #3 will be designated as the infant/toddler classroom. The room measures 32ft x 16ft totaling 512 square feet and can accommodate up to 10 infant/toddlers ages birth to three years of age. The licensee is requesting a capacity of 8. The classroom has a hand washing sink next to the designated diapering area and a separate sink for food preparation.

The previous license classrooms:

- Room 1 is approximately 620 square feet and can accommodate up to 17 children age two and a half to five.
- Room 2 is approximately 668 square feet and can accommodate up to 17 children age two and a half to five.
- The large muscle room is approximately 518 square feet and can accommodate 14 children age two and a half to five.

There are a total of four toilets and four hand-washing sinks. This supports the center total capacity. An environmental health inspection was completed on 10/21/2014. The center received an A rating.

A fire and lead hazard risk assessment were not required.

There is an adequate amount of age and developmentally appropriate equipment for all ages being served.

There is a fenced outdoor play area.

The center is open Monday thru Friday from 8:00am to 4:00pm. Breakfast, lunch and snack will be served.

The center will supply formula and diapers. Currently the center is only accepting children 18 months and older.

The current program director is Stephanie Coleman. She is approved under licensing rules R400.8113(9)(c) and (13).

V. Recommendation

I recommend an infant toddler component (room 3) be added to the license and the capacity of the center be changed from 52 to 42.
