Ms. Schroeder submitted a request for modification to add the great room and sleeping room on the main level of the home as additional child use space.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Ms. Schroeder has been a licensed child care provider since August of 2011. She resides in a two-story house with a basement located in a rural area of Bronson. She has requested to add the great room and sleeping room located on the main level of her home as additional child use space. The approved child use space includes:

Main Level: kitchen, dining room, living room, entryway, play room, great room and sleeping room.

The upper level and basement are not approved for child use. The basement will only be used for conducting tornado drills and during actual tornado emergencies. The rooms approved on the main level of the home have a sufficient amount of space and play equipment to accommodate the licensed capacity of 12 children ages birth to 12 years of age.

There is a bathroom located on the main level of the home for child care use. The home has adequate fire exits. The main level uses two remote door way exits which exit directly to grade.

Ms. Schroeder has completed the required radon testing on 06/13/11 with a radon test result of 1.3 picocuries per liter of air. She is in compliance with the licensing standards of not more than 4 picocuries per liter of air. There were no variances requested for this licensed family group home.

V. Recommendation

I approve the addition of the great room and sleeping room located on the main level of the home for additional approved child use space.
