II. Purpose of Addendum

On March 27, 2015, Ms. Sheryl Westerdale, Licensee, requested to increase the age range from three to four years of age. There is no capacity increase.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On March 16, 2015, Nanny's Infant and Toddler Center requested to provide services to children up to four years of age. Currently, they're licensed to provide care for infants and children up to three years of age. According to Ms. Sheryl Westerdale, Licensee, some of the children, approximately 1-2, are not emotionally or developmentally ready to leave the facility after three years and require a little more time, specifically with potty training. She does not anticipate children having to stay past forty-two months, but will extend up to age four. The extension of care of forty-two months to age four is offered to families of children currently enrolled at the facility only.

The 609 square feet yellow room is approved for children 30 to 48 months. The classroom is of mixed age groups therefore the ratio is determined by the age of the youngest child. There may not be more than 12 children in this classroom.

There are two toilets and one hand washing sink at the facility.

The facility has adequate and developmentally appropriate equipment.

The current program director is Kathleen Gardiner. Ms. Gardiner is approved under R. 400.8113(9)(3). All required clearances and credentials are on file with the department.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the license be modified to include care for children up to four years of age.
