II. Purpose of Addendum

On October 13, 2015, the licensee requested we add the orange room to the approved child use space. The licensee also requested we change the age ranges to serve children birth through 5 years instead of birth to 12 years.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on December 30, 2015.

The center is located on the Northwest side of Three Rivers. The Red Room, Blue Room, Green Room, Purple Room, Pink Room, and Yellow Room were previously approved. The licensee would like to add the Orange Room to the approved child use space. The following rooms have been approved:

The facility has sufficient square footage to support the licensee's request for a capacity of 72 children ages birth through 5 years. The center has the required amount of developmentally appropriate and varied equipment for the ages and capacity requested.

The children in the center have access to a total of seven toilets and eight hand washing sinks. Since the program operates more than five continuous hours, this

meets the requirements for at least one toilet and one hand washing sink to every fifteen children.

The outdoor play area is located behind the center, is completely fenced, and does not contain any water hazards. A playground safety inspection was completed on July 12, 2007. The swings and composite structure were approved for use. On May 13, 2015, the Merry-Go-Round and Super Tree House Slide were both installed and approved for children ages 3 and up.

The center is open Monday through Friday from 5:30 AM to 6:00 PM. Both full-time and part-time sessions are offered. The center does not provide any food service, transportation, or swimming components. Parents provide breakfast and lunch from home. Parents take turns providing morning snacks for their child's classroom. The center provides an afternoon snack and milk.

A lead hazard risk assessment was not required for this center because the facility was built in 2004. R 400.8380(8) only requires a lead hazard risk assessment if the facility was built before 1978. An environmental health inspection was completed on August 28, 2015, and received an "A" rating. A fire safety inspection was completed on September 3, 2013, and received an "A" rating. A new fire safety inspection was not required because the Orange Room had been previously inspected and approved. Ed de Varona, Qualified Fire Safety Inspector, provided email verification on September 9, 2015, that the space was approved for toddlers. No variances have been requested or approved.

The approved program director is Toni Schiedel. Ms. Schiedel meets the requirements for R 400.8113(14). She has been employed as an approved program director at the center since November 12, 1996.

V. Recommendation

I recommend adding the orange room to the approved child use space for children ages 12 months through 18 months. I recommend changing the age ranges to serve children from birth through age five years.
