III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

The ranch style home is located in a rural farm community in Clare County. The home has an attached two car garage and walk out basement.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use: The living room on the main floor is approved for child care. The kitchenette, playroom, and two bedrooms in the basement are approved for child care use. The bathroom used for child care is located in the basement between bedroom one and bedroom two.

Areas not approved: The kitchen and the bedrooms on the main floor are not approved for child care use.

Ages of children served: The child care group home will serve children birth through 11 years of age.

Equipment: There is a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment for children birth to 11 years of age. Equipment includes blocks, storybooks, play kitchen, puzzles, games, musical instruments, cars, pack 'n' plays, high chairs, child sized table and chairs and various other materials.

Proposed days and hours of operation: The child care group home is open Monday through Friday from 6:30 am to 5:30 pm.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care: The licensee, Rebecca Rodgers, was previously registered as a family home DF180243283 from 11/15/2001 to 11/27/2016.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are two exits on the main floor. The first exit is located in the living room and provides egress to the front yard. The second exit is located in the foyer and provides egress to the driveway. There are two exits in the basement. The first exit is in the playroom and provides egress to the backyard. The second exit is up the stairwell to the door on the main floor and provides egress to the front yard.

Outdoor play area description: The outdoor play area is located in the backyard directly outside of the playroom in the basement. There is a fenced in area directly to the right of the door with a variety of Little Tykes climbers and equipment including balls, buckets, and ride on toys. A large hill and open back yard provide plenty of room for children to run and play games. There is another fenced in play yard towards the back of the yard. The second fenced in play area is neither approved nor used for child care. An enclosed fence divides this area from the approved child use space.
