II. Purpose of Addendum

On 03/14/2017 Ms. Carter requested that her master bedroom and master bathroom be removed as approved child use space.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 03/14/2017.

On 03/14/2017 Ms. Carter stated that the master bedroom and bathroom are no longer used for child care and she keeps the door closed during child care hours.

A. Description of Facility

The facility is a one story home with a basement located on the outskirts of Cheboygan.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use:

The approved child care space in the basement includes: the playroom. The approved child use space on the main floor includes: the living room, kitchen, dining room, two bedrooms and bathroom.

Areas not approved:

The two storage rooms and wood stove room located in the basement are neither used nor approved for child care. The master bedroom and bathroom located on the main floor are neither used nor approved for child care. The two detached garages on the property are neither used nor approved for child care.

Ages of children served: Ms. Carter accepts children ages birth to 12 years.

Equipment: There is a sufficient supply of developmentally appropriate equipment for the requested capacity of six children.

Proposed days and hours of operation: This facility operates Monday through Friday 7:30am- 5:30pm

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care: Ms. Carter has not been previously licensed for child care. Ms. Carter is not currently licensed for foster care.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are two exits from the basement of the home. The first exit is the basement window located in the storage room next to the playroom. The window is large enough to allow for the evacuation of caregivers and children. There are steps leading to the window that are affixed to the wall. The window provides egress to the back yard at ground level. The second exit is the stairs which provide egress to the main floor of the home. There are three exits from the main floor of the home. The first exit is the front door located in the living room and provides egress to the front yard. The second exit is the side door located in the entry way off the kitchen and provides egress to the front yard. The third exit is the sliding glass door in the dining room and provides egress to the back yard.

Outdoor play area description: The outdoor play area is located in the fully fenced back yard.

There are no water hazards on the property. There are two small dogs and one cat in the home. Ms. Carter stated that all the animals have supervised contact with the children in care. There is a fireplace in the living room. Ms. Carter stated that the fireplace is not used during child care hours. There is a wood stove in the basement that is used to heat the home. There is a child proof handle on the door where the wood stove is located in the basement. There is also a hook and eye latch on the door that is too high to be accessible to children.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the removal of the master bedroom and bathroom as approved child use space. The approved child care space in the basement includes: the playroom. The approved child use space on the main floor includes: the living room, kitchen, dining room, two bedrooms and bathroom.
