## **IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions**

The family child care home is located in the village of Climax. The home is a single story structure with a basement. The main floor living room, entry/dining room, kitchen, two bedrooms, and the bathroom on the west side of the home are approved for child care use. The registrant would like to add the master bedroom to the approved child use space.

The master bathroom and laundry room on the main level of the home are not approved for care. The basement level of the home is not approved except in severe weather emergencies.

The main level of the home has three standard door exits properly terminated to grade. There is a front door, a side door, and a back sliding door.

The outdoor play area is located behind the house and is completely fenced. The wooden play structure will not be used by the children in care because it does not have safe surfacing material beneath it. The provider will use portable playground equipment with the children in care. The registrant does not have any hot tubs, swimming pools, fireplaces, wood burning stoves, or water hazards on the premises. The family home has two small dogs.

The registrant has a sufficient supply of developmentally appropriate and varied equipment to accommodate the requested capacity of six children. The registrant will accept children from 12 months old through age seventeen. The family child care home is open Monday through Friday from 5:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

Ms. Gross has not been previously registered/licensed as a child care provider and has not ever been licensed to provide children's foster care. No variances have been requested or approved.

**V. Recommendation**

I recommend approval of the modification to include the master bedroom as approved child use space.
