Dear Ms. Dingo:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 03/13/2018. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1924 Hand washing.

- (2) Caregiving staff shall assure that children wash their hands at the following times:
- (a) Before and after meals, snacks, or food preparation experiences.

I observed four children eat snack without washing their hands before or after snack was served. The license, Kelli Dingo, stated that she is aware that children need to wash their hands before and after snack and she will begin to ensure that children wash their hands immediately.

R 400.1941 Heat-producing equipment.

- (2) Combustible materials and equipment shall not be stored within 4 feet of furnaces, other flame or heat-producing equipment, or fuel-fired water heaters.

I observed a variety of items including boxes, wood, paper and other combustible materials within 4 feet of the furnace and hot water heater. Ms. Dingo stated that she is aware that items cannot be stored within 4 feet of the furnace or hot water heater and she will remove the items immediately.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED
LSR dated 02/13/2017
Corrective Action Plan dated 02/10/2017

R 400.1942 Electrical service; maintenance.

(2) All electrical outlets, including outlets on multiple outlet devices, accessible to children shall have safety covers.

One outlet cover was missing in the bathroom and one was missing in the basement family room. Ms. Dingo stated that she is aware that the outlets must have safety covers.

I observed free play and snack. I provided technical assistance and consultation on screen (TV) time and emergency exits.


Violations were identified at the time of the inspection. You have provided an acceptable written corrective action plan.
