Dear Ms. Blystone:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 09/06/2018. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1945 Fire; tornado; serious accident and injury plans.

(3) Fire drills shall be practiced at least once a month and a written record that includes the date and time it takes to evacuate shall be maintained.

A written record for a fire drill that included the date and time it takes to evacuate was not maintained for August of 2018. The licensee Barbara Blystone stated that she did complete a fire drill in August, but she forgot to record it. She is aware that fire drills must be practiced at least once a month and a written record must be maintained.

R 400.1945 Fire; tornado; serious accident and injury plans.

(4) Tornado drills shall be practiced once a month, April to October, and a written record that includes the date shall be maintained.

A written record for a tornado drill that included the date was not maintained for August of 2018. Ms. Blystone stated that she did complete a tornado drill in August, but she forgot to record it. She is aware that tornado drills must be practiced at least once a month, April to October, and a written record must be maintained.

I observed free play, rest time, and infant feeding. Ms. Blystone and her assistant caregiver were nurturing and quick to respond to the individual needs of the children in care.

Violations were identified at the time of the inspection. You have provided an acceptable written corrective action plan.

A follow-up inspection may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be made in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

The Department provides technical assistance to meet the licensing requirements and consultation to improve services.
