III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

Ms. Parker resides in a two-level home with a Michigan-style basement in Kingsley.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use: The main level open-concept living room/dining room/kitchen and the main level bedroom are approved for child care use.

Areas not approved: The upper level of the home, the Michigan-style basement, and the unattached garage are not approved for child care use.

Ages of children served: Ms. Parker will care for children ages birth-17.

Equipment: Ms. Parker has an adequate number of toys and materials including baby dolls, play cars, small play animals, and books.

Proposed days and hours of operation: Ms. Parker will operate from 12:00am-11:59pm, Sunday-Saturday.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care: Ms. Parker was previously registered to provide child care and licensed for foster care (DF280382290), (DF280336556), (DF280373332), and (CF280207333). She is not currently licensed for foster care.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The front door exits to a porch and the front yard. There is a French-style door which exits the dining room to a deck and the back yard and a door which exits the mudroom to the back yard.

Outdoor play area description: The children will play in the unfenced back yard. Located in the back yard there is evidence of a decorative pond which was under snow cover during the inspection. Ms. Parker stated that the pond has been filled in and is no longer a water hazard. There are no other water or other hazards. There are sleds, balls and two toddler climbing structures available to children.

- Pets? No Yes If yes, describe. There are three small dogs and a cat in the home. The children will have access to the pets. All of the pets were friendly during the inspection.

B. Rule/Statutory Violations

There are no rule violations at this time.

Note: There is no approvable infant sleeping equipment in the home at this time. Ms. Parker stated that if she enrolls any infants, she will ensure she has compliant sleeping equipment with tightly-fitted sheets. Ms. Parker also understands that to provide overnight care for an infant she must have a compliant crib.

Note: Ms. Parker understands that when overnight care is provided, she must sleep on the main level of the home and that the upper level of the bunk bed available for children to use for sleeping must only be used when age and developmentally appropriate.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of an original license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
