The second stairway leads to the front door on the main level of the home.

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on-site inspection the programming I observed included the following: snack, free play and diapering. I observed the caregiver's interactions with the children in care to be developmentally appropriate and responsive to their needs.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the exit conference, I provided technical assistance and consultation to Ms. Marshall on the following: volunteer policy, assistant caregiver requirements, annual permission for walking field trips and written emergency plans posted on each level approved for child care.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a registered license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
