**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the onset inspection, I observed teachers providing appropriate care and supervision. The facility was clean and I did not observe any safety hazards.

During the exit conference, I provided consultation regarding the following:

- Please reinforce the plastic liners under tables to prevent them from curling.
- Fire drills evacuation times should **only** include how long it takes to exit the building.
- Review the Center Checklist regarding required postings located on the department's website.
- Teachers with CDA's must have transcripts on file and 480 Hours of Experience letter.
- The new Emergency Preparedness Plan must be posted like all procedures under R. 400.8161(1)(a-d). Sample plans are located at [www.michigan.gov/michildcare](http://www.michigan.gov/michildcare)

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
