II. Purpose of Addendum

On 9/25/2018 Little Tykes University submitted a modification request to add an additional classroom in an unattached building on the property for child care use space. An increase in the capacity to 68 was requested.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license were modified on 12/17/2018.

On 9/25/2018 the department received a request to add a room in a building adjacent to the facility as child care use space. The unattached building will be used as an infant classroom for children birth to 18 months. The unattached building consists of one large room named the Freshman 102 classroom. The second half of the building is inaccessible to children and will not be used for child care use.

The Freshman 102 classroom measures approximately 14' x 3' for a square footage of 42, 20' x 12' for a square footage of 240, and 23' x 19' for a square footage of 437. The new classroom's total square footage is 719 which will allow for the requested capacity of 12 infant and toddler aged children. The Freshman 102 classroom has one bathroom with one toilet and one sink. There is also a small kitchen with a sink and full-size refrigerator. The room currently has eight cribs and five sleeping mats. The Freshman 102 classroom will only allow eight infants under the age of 12 months until more cribs are placed in this room. The center is aware that infants are required to sleep on demand and they need to have a crib for each infant, under the age of 12 months, in the classroom. There is plenty of age appropriate equipment and toys.

Previously approved space includes:

Freshman 101: (0-18 months) measures 20' x 14' for a total square footage 280. This will allow for the requested capacity of 4 infants. There is one sink and one diapering area in this room.

Sophomore 102: (12 months – 30 months) previously known as Freshman 102 measures 13' x 15' for a total square footage of 195. This will allow for the requested capacity of 4 infants. There is one toilet, one sink, and one diapering area in this room.

Sophomore: (18 months- 30 months) measures 27' x 13' for a square footage of 351 and 35' x 11' for a square footage of 385. Total square footage for this room is 736 which will allow for the requested capacity of 12 toddler age children. There is one toilet, one sink, and one diapering area in this room.

Junior: (30 months- 3 years 6 months) measures 37' x 18' for a total square footage of 666. This will allow for the requested capacity of 16 toddler age children. There are two toilets, two sinks, and one diapering area in this room.

Senior: (3 years 6 months – school age) measures 6' x 8' for a square footage of 48, 26' x 22' for a square footage of 572, 6' x 20' for a square footage of 120, and 7' x 23' for a square footage of 161. Total square footage for this room is 901 which will allow for the requested capacity of 20 preschoolers and school agers. There is one toilet and two sinks in this room.

A fire inspection was completed on 11/28/2018 with a 'A' rating.

An environmental health inspection was completed on 12/06/2018 with a 'A' rating.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the approval of the Freshman 102 classroom and the increase in the center capacity to 68.
