Dear Ms. Yoder:

Attached is the Special Investigation Report for the above referenced facility. The following rule violations were found during the course of this investigation:

<b>R400.1911(1)</b>	<b>Supervision.</b> (1) The caregiver shall assure appropriate care and supervision of children at all times.
<b>R400.1913(2)</b>	<b>Discipline and child handling.</b> (2) Developmentally appropriate positive methods of discipline which encourage self-control, self-direction, self-esteem, and cooperation shall be used.
<b>R400.1931(4)(c)</b>	<b>Food preparation and service.</b> (4) Food shall be prepared, served, and stored in a safe and sanitary manner. All of the following shall apply: (c) Children under 3 years of age shall not be served or allowed to eat foods that may easily cause choking including, but not limited to, popcorn and uncut round foods such as grapes, seeds, nuts, hard candy, and hot dogs.

Due to the violations identified in the report, a written corrective action plan is required. The corrective action plan is due 15 days from the date of this letter and must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

If you desire technical assistance in addressing these issues, please feel free to contact me. In any event, the corrective action plan is due within 15 days.

Per MCL 722.113g, this letter and any related corrective action plans must be filed in your licensing notebook. Due to statutory restrictions, the attached special investigation report cannot be shared with parents or filed in your Licensing Notebook.
