The purpose of this addendum is to provide documentation of approval for the finished basement for child care usage.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license were modified on August 28, 2019.

Mrs. Moore was previously approved to provide child care on the main level of her home. Mrs. Moore has a finished basement and has requested to provide care in the lower level of her home. Mrs. Moore will no longer be providing care on the main level of her home.

The finished basement is open and consists of a kitchen, dining area, and play area. A room used for napping, and a bathroom. The remainder of the basement is not approved for child care usage and includes an office space, utility room and storage.

The napping room has a properly installed egress window exit. The exit is 43 inches from the floor. The egress window is 3.2 feet in height and 2.8 feet in length. The window is labeled and easily opened. A second exit is a staircase which leads to a landing and entry door to the driveway of the home.

Directly behind the home is an inground swimming pool. The area is enclosed with a locking gated fence. Outdoor play occurs in the backyard separate from the inground swimming pool. The area is fenced separate from the swimming pool. The area has several pieces of residential playground equipment with surfacing material.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the finished basement for child care usage. I recommend removal of approval of the main level for child care usage.
