Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are four exits from the main floor of the home. Two exits are remote of each other and provide egress to the outside. The first exit is located off the dining room and provides egress to the outside front yard of the home. The second exit is located off the living room and provides egress to the outside back yard of the home. The additional two exits are as follows: the second exit off the dining room that leads out to the deck that you must walk down the side of the home and around to the front by the front exit of the home; there is also an exit off the kitchen through the attached garage. The path through the garage is narrow.
