III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of applicable key indicator child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of some of the home's records, including staff and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.


The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Ms. Wentworth is currently caring for her preschool-age grandchild and seven school-age children. On 10/24/2019 I observed Ms. Wentworth caring for her grandchild and on 10/25/2019 I observed Ms. Wentworth caring for three school-age children after school. On 10/25/2019 the school-age children had just finished an outside scavenger hunt designed by Ms. Wentworth, they had started a Lego structure in the living room, and they were busy playing football in the yard. Ms. Wentworth provided a variety of developmentally appropriate activities.

I was unable to observe bodily care and safe sleep because Ms. Wentworth does not currently have any young children enrolled in her program.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular family child care license.
