

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8176 Sleeping equipment.

(11) Blankets shall not be draped over cribs or porta-cribs when in use.

A blanket was draped over the side of an empty crib.

Observations:

Both the infant/toddlers and preschoolers were engaged in developmentally appropriate free play. The children then prepared for and ate lunch.

Consultation was provided in regards to the difference between a sleep sack and a swaddle. Staff were reminded that infants can be swaddled up to two months of age.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 11/14/2019. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
