There is one large dog and one cat in the home. The children in care have access to both the cat and the dog. The dog was friendly during the inspection and Ms. Middaugh stated the cat was present but likely hiding.

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, I observed Ms. Middaugh caring for an infant, a preschool-age child, and a related child home from school due to illness. Ms. Middaugh cared for the children with kindness and met their needs quickly and with care.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1907**

**Child's records.**

**(3) Dated daily attendance records of children in care must be maintained and include the child's first and last name and the time of arrival and departure. Electronic records may be used. If electronic records are used, they must be available to the department at the time of the inspection. If electronic attendance records are not available during an on-site inspection, the child care home is in violation of this rule.**

Ms. Middaugh did not ensure daily attendance was maintained. There was no daily attendance for 01/13/2020 and 01/14/2020. Ms. Middaugh stated that she had just missed completing the attendance record for the day of the inspection and the day before.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 01/14/2020. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

During the inspection, I provided technical assistance regarding:

- Training offered through MiRegistry.org.
- Diapering regarding location of diapering area
- Maintaining the fire drill log

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a original license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
