- R 400.8137(1)(c) Diapering; toileting.



III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8122

Lead caregiver; qualifications; responsibilities.

(6) Lead caregivers qualified under subrule (5), Table 3, row (g) of this rule, have 2 years from date of hire in this position to obtain an additional 6 semester hours, 9 CEUs, or a combination to equal 90 clock hours, or 90 hours from MiRegistry.

At the time of the inspection, the infant room does not have a qualified lead caregiver. The program director Terrie Stratton acknowledged that their lead caregiver recently left the center and they are in the process of replacing her.

R 400.8137

Diapering; toileting.

(1) Except as provided in subrule (2) of this rule, diapering must occur in a designated diapering area that complies with all of the following:

(c) Has non-absorbent, smooth, easily cleanable surfaces in good repair.

At the time of the inspection, the diaper pads in the toddler rooms had tears in them. Ms. Stratton stated that she would replace the pads immediately.

R 400.8143

Children's records.

(3) For children under school-age, at the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain, keep on file, and make accessible in the center 1 of the following:

(a) A certificate of immunization showing a minimum of 1 dose of each immunizing agent specified by the department of health and human services (DHHS).

(b) A copy of a waiver addressed to DHHS and signed by the parent stating immunizations are not being administered due to religious, medical, or other reasons.

At the time of the inspection, 2 of 10 children's files had an immunization record that was not on file at the time of initial attendance.

R 400.8143

Children's records.

(6) Within 30 days of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain, keep on file, and make accessible in the center a record of a physical evaluation of the child that notes any restrictions and is signed by a physician or the physician's designee. An electronic record from a physician's office will be accepted. The physical evaluation must be performed within 1 of the following time limits:

- (a) For an infant, within the preceding 3 months.
- (b) For toddlers, within the preceding 6 months.
- (c) For preschoolers, within the preceding 12 months.

At the time of the inspection, 1 of 10 children's files had a healthcare appraisal that was completed 41 days after initial attendance. Ms. Stratton acknowledged that it was completed after the required timeframe.

Emergency procedures.

(5) A fire drill program, consisting of at least 1 fire drill quarterly, must be established and implemented.

A review of the 2019 fire drill records showed that a fire drill was not completed in the first quarter of the year, and the third quarter of the year. I discussed the quarterly requirements with Ms. Stratton and how to achieve compliance with the rule. The 2018 fire drills were not complete and there was not a record on file for them. Only 2 fire drills were recorded for 2018.

During the inspection I provided Ms. Stratton with technical assistance on the following rules:


- Dating all opened milk (corrected onsite)
- Completing the Health and Safety Trainings for all staff members
- Documenting emergency training 2x/year
- Documenting staff member orientation at the time of hire

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 02/13/2020. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify

compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license.
