

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records.

Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all the applicable rules and statues.

The center provides the children with a variety of play and learning experiences. I provided a rule review regarding infant safe sleep and the new center rules. The center contains a small slide that is not currently being used. If the center wishes to use this slide, a passing certified playground inspection is required.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
