**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1905            Training.**

**(1) A licensee shall complete not less than 10 clock hours of training each calendar year related to child development, program planning, and administrative management for a child care business, not including CPR, first aid, and infectious disease, including immunizations, training.**

During the onsite inspection on 03/11/2020, Ms. Micheaux did not provide documentation of 10 clock hours of required training for 2019.

**R 400.1905            Training.**

**(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:**  
**(a) Safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome.**

During the onsite inspection on 03/11/2020, Ms. Micheaux did not provide documentation for her Child Care Staff Members of the 5 clock hours of required training for 2019: specifically safe sleep practices.

During the onsite inspection on 03/11/2020, the children sang songs such as, "If You're Happy and You Know it," "Special Me," and a song that spelled out each child's name. The children learn daily, their numbers, letters, shapes as well as a wealth of other foundational skills that prepare children for Kindergarten. Technical Assistance was provided to Licensee regarding the importance of attending required yearly trainings. Consultation was provided regarding the organization of important documents.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home.
