The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Ms. Killingsworth did not have documentation of her furnace and water heater inspection, medical clearance, and up to date CPR and First Aid due to Covid-19. She agreed to complete these items and send them in as soon as appointments can be made.

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
