**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

I arrived at the facility during naptime. When I arrived, there were four children napping in the infant room with one caregiver, four children napping in the toddler room with one caregiver, and six children playing in the preschool room with two caregivers. When children woke from their nap, they were brought to the preschool room to engage in free play. I observed positive interactions between the caregivers and children.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the exit conference, technical assistance/consultation was provided regarding the following:

- The center's crisis management plan, include for intruders, is posted in multiple conspicuous locations throughout the center. I suggested that these be moved to a location within each room that is known by staff but not visible to outsiders.
- I requested that Ms. Janice Ervay move the handwashing sign by the infant room to a location where it can be seen by children.
- I encouraged Ms. Ervay to not fill in any information on child information cards, including changing "N/A" to "none". These documents must be completed fully by the child's parent or guardian.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
