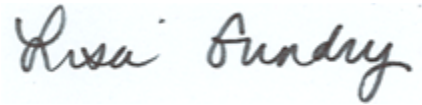

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and

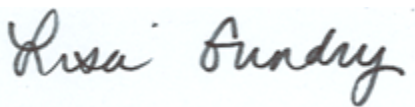
training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the inspection, I provided Ms. Pea technical assistance and consultation on the following rules:

- Rule 915(5) Product Safety Recall List – Ms. Pea had an outdated Recall list from 2018. I mailed Ms. Pea an updated safety recall list.
- Rule 903(8)(b) - No Vaping - I provided Ms. Pea a No Vaping sign.
- Rule 945(2) - Ms. Pea did not have the updated written emergency procedures. I mailed her a sample copy to follow,
- Rule 941(5) - Ms. Pea had not completed a furnace inspection due to Covid-19. She indicated that she would schedule an inspection as quickly as possible.
- Rule 905(7) - Ms. Pea had an outdated CPR and First Aid card. Due to Covid-19 she was unable to take a class to update her card. She indicated that she would schedule a training class as quickly as possible.
- Rule 906(1)(c)(i) - Ms. Pea did not have an updated physical completed for the renewal. She indicated that she would schedule an appointment as quickly as possible. I mailed her a copy of a physical form for completion.
- Rule 905(4) – Ms. Pea did not have written documentation of the required health and safety courses 1 and 2 completed.
