**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

As a result of the renewal inspection on 11/24/2020, I did not find any rule or law violations.

During the inspection, I observed children engaged in table activities, using their Chromebooks for schoolwork, and playing in the gym. The children benefit from the opportunities to explore various materials and outdoor activities in this play-based program.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
