Dear Ms. Pierik & Ms. Wirth:

This letter is a follow-up to LSR dated 10/27/2020. As a result of the renewal inspection completed on 10/19/2020 the center was cited for the following 25 violations: R 400.8110 (14), R 400.8110 (3)(c), R 400.8110 (4), R 400.8110 (6), R 400.8122 (5), R 400.8122 (7), R 400.8125 (4), R 400.8131 (3), R 400.8131 (4), R 400.8131(5) (a-g), R 400.8131(6) (a-h), R 400.8143 (1), R 400.8143 (11), R 400.8146 (1)(l)(i), R 400.8146 (1) (l) (iii), R 400.8155 (1)(b), R 400.8155 (5), R 400.8161 (2)(c), R 400.8161 (2)(d), R 400.8161 (2)(g), R 400.8161 (2)(h), R 400.8161 (8), R 400.8315 (3), R 400.8380 (5), and R400.8510 (6). Of the 25 violations cited during the 10/19/2021 onsite inspection 15 violations were repeats. As a result of the repeat violations, the department recommended refusal to renew the license of this child care center.

On 02/03/2021, a compliance conference was scheduled to discuss the refusal to renew process and departmental options to resolve this matter without a hearing. During that compliance conference you expressed an interest in maintaining your child care license. You presented several documents to show your implemented changes at the center regarding written policies, staff qualifications and trainings, and postings. On 02/10/2021 you provided additional documentation to verify compliance with children's files, and staff training and qualifications.

Based on the compliance conference dated 02/03/2021, an agreement was made to resolve this matter without a hearing, thus resulting in a different licensing action. Specifically, a settlement agreement was reached in which you agreed to the issuance of a six-month, 3rd provisional license. On 03/11/2021 you submit an acceptable written corrective action plan to address the violations.

On 05/12/2021 an onsite inspection was completed to ensure your implementation of the corrective action plan, and you expressed an understanding that you waived your right to an administrative hearing in this matter. The center was found to be in compliance with all of the rules and laws and a confirming letter was sent on 05/13/2021.

On 05/17/2021 the Child Care Licensing director accepted and signed the settlement agreement. On 05/17/2021 you signed the settlement agreement accepting the 3<sup>rd</sup> provisional license. As a result, the center was issued a six-month, 3<sup>rd</sup> provisional license effective 05/17/2021.


