III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8143	Children's records.
	(1) At the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain a child information card, using a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute, that is completed and signed by the child's parent. The center shall keep it on file and accessible in the center.
Several of the child information cards were missing required content such as, physician phone numbers, employer details, allergies/special needs, and signature.	
R 400.8143	Children's records.
	(11) A center shall maintain an accurate record of daily attendance at the center that includes each child's first and last name and each child's arrival and departure time. Electronic records may be used. If electronic attendance records are used, then they must be available to the department at the time of an inspection. If the electronic attendance records are not available during an on-site inspection, then the center is in violation of this rule.
One of the classrooms did not have accurate arrival times inputted on attendance record.	
R 400.8340	Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.
	(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.
Lunch bags provided by parents were not labeled with the child's first and last name and date.	
R 400.8550	Electrical service.
	(5) All electrical outlets in child use areas for children who are not yet school-age shall be made inaccessible to children.
Electrical outlets were accessible to children in both classrooms.	


TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE:

R 400.8113 Program director approval letters should be on file.

R 400.8131(8) Ongoing professional development plan should address trainings issued by the department required within 6 months of issuance.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to the child care facility.
