II. Purpose of Addendum

The center added full walls where half walls use to be. The rooms were re-measured which resulted in a change of capacity from 100 to 93.

III. Methodology

3/30/2004 – On-site visit for their renewal – saw walls being built, and re-measured all rooms.

3/05/2004 – Environmental health inspection completed.

5/25/2004 – Fire inspection completed.

6/29/2004 – Modification letter received.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The center's rooms go around in a circle. The rooms were measured from right to left. The room measurements are as follows:

Room #1 – 3 year old room

$22.8 \times 23.11 = 542.08$ divided by 35 square feet = 15 children

Room #2 – 2 ½ to 3 year old room

$23.0 \times 23.6 = 540.5$ divided by 35 square feet = 15 children

Room #3 – 1 to 2 year old room

$23.10 \times 21.7 = 514.32$ divided by 50 square feet = 10 children

Room #4 – Infants, birth to 1 year old room

$21.7 \times 19.0 = 410.08$ divided by 50 square feet = 8 children

Room #5 – 4 year old room

$30.5 \times 24.0 = 729.98$ divided by 35 square feet = 20 children

Room #6 – Kindergarten/School-age room

$37.3 \times 23.10 = 887.67$ divided by 35 square feet = 25 children

The addition of the full walls where the half walls use to be resulted in the capacity of this center to go from 100 down to 93.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended that this CDC center remain on a regular license with the capacity of 93 children.
